

When in Rome by Sarah Adams is a romantic comedy filled with humor and heartwarming moments. The story follows Amelia Rose, a pop star in desperate need of an escape from her overwhelming public life. Inspired by Audrey Hepburn's Roman Holiday, she decides to go to the small-town of Rome, Kentucky. With a broken-down vehicle, she ends up stranded on the doorstep of Noah Walker, a grumpy yet charming local baker with no interest in her celebrity drama. Sparks fly as they spend time together and eventually their playful banter turns into undeniable chemistry. Noah and Amelia have a multitude of reasons to not risk their hearts, but what will they do if one of them lets their guard down? In this slow-burn romance, Adams perfectly balances lighthearted comedy
